(1) 179 mandatory credits (including 4 credits for on-campus internships and 66 credits for off-campus internships).

(2) 17 elective credits:

A. At least 13 elective credits from the department (including at least 13 credits from designated medical humanities elective courses).

B. Up to 4 elective credits from other departments can be recognized (general education, physical education, and national defense military education courses are not included).

(3) General Education Credits: Please refer to the General Education Center's course regulations. A total of 25 credits are required, including courses in the Holistic Education domain, English domain, Core curriculum, and Diverse curriculum.

2. Physical Education: Required 0 credits for freshmen and sophomores.

3. English Graduation Requirement: The student must meet the university's English proficiency requirement to graduate. Please refer to the Language Center for details.

Other Regulations:

4. Students must complete a total of 9 credits in the core foundational courses (marked with *) before you can take the mandatory course "Medical Humanities and Clinical Ethics" in your fourth year. (For those taking the core medical humanities foundational courses for the first time, priority should be given to courses offered by the School of Medicine.)

5. Medical Humanities (I) elective course-group includes a total of three courses: "Understanding the Sociology of Health", "Bioethics", "Historical Survey of Public Health". Medical Humanities (II) elective course-group includes a total of four courses: "Gender and Medicine", "Language, Narrative and Healing", "Shi-literati and Chinese Culture", "Science, Technology and Medicine". The elective courses in medical humanities are divided into two groups: (I) and (II). Each group requires students to select at least one course.

6. Students must fulfill all course requirements for the medical humanities courses from the first to the third year in order to enroll in the mandatory course 'Medical Humanities and Clinical Ethics' in the fourth year.

7. The AI field course "Introduction to Artificial Intelligence" (1 credit) can only be retaken within courses offered by the Department of Medicine or Traditional Chinese Medicine.

8. Elective Courses: "Research of Life Science" (1 credit, for years 1 to 6), "Biology(II)" (2 credits, 1st-year spring semester), "Interpersonal Relations Theory and Application" (2 credits, 2nd-year fall semester), "Cell and Molecular Systems Biology" (2 credits, 2nd-year spring semester), "Health Services Research: Methodology in Social and Behavior Sciences" (2 credits, 2nd-year spring semester), "Medical Taiwanese" (1 credit, 4th-year fall semester), "Hospice Care" (2 credits, 4th-year fall semester), "ECG Interpretation" (1 credit, 4th-year spring semester), "Basic 9. Critical Care" (1 credit, 4th-year spring semester), "Evidence-based Medicine" (1 credit, 4th-year spring semester), "Medical Mycology" (1 credit, 4th-year spring semester), "Principle and Practice of Medical Records" (1 credit, 5th-year fall semester), "Emergency Medicine" (2 credits, 5th-year fall semester), "Clinical Reasoning" (1 credit, 5th-year spring semester), "Point of care Ultrasound" (2 credits, 6th-year spring semester).

9. Approval from the course instructor is required to take upgrade courses.
