(2) Elective courses count for 24 credits (at least 12 credits in Dept. of Industrial and Business Management; a maximum of 12 credits can be recognized for courses in Dept. of Health Care Management, Dept. of Industrial Design, Dept. of Information Management and MBA program, Graduate Institute of Asset Management). (3) Thesis counts for 6 credits. (Credits will be given after passing the master oral examination and submitting an approved thesis.) 2. Students must meet the English standard requirement in order to graduate. 3. International students who do not have a required (elective) course in English may take the same course title at another school in the College of Management; Courses with different subject names may be taken only after review and approval by the Departmental Council.
