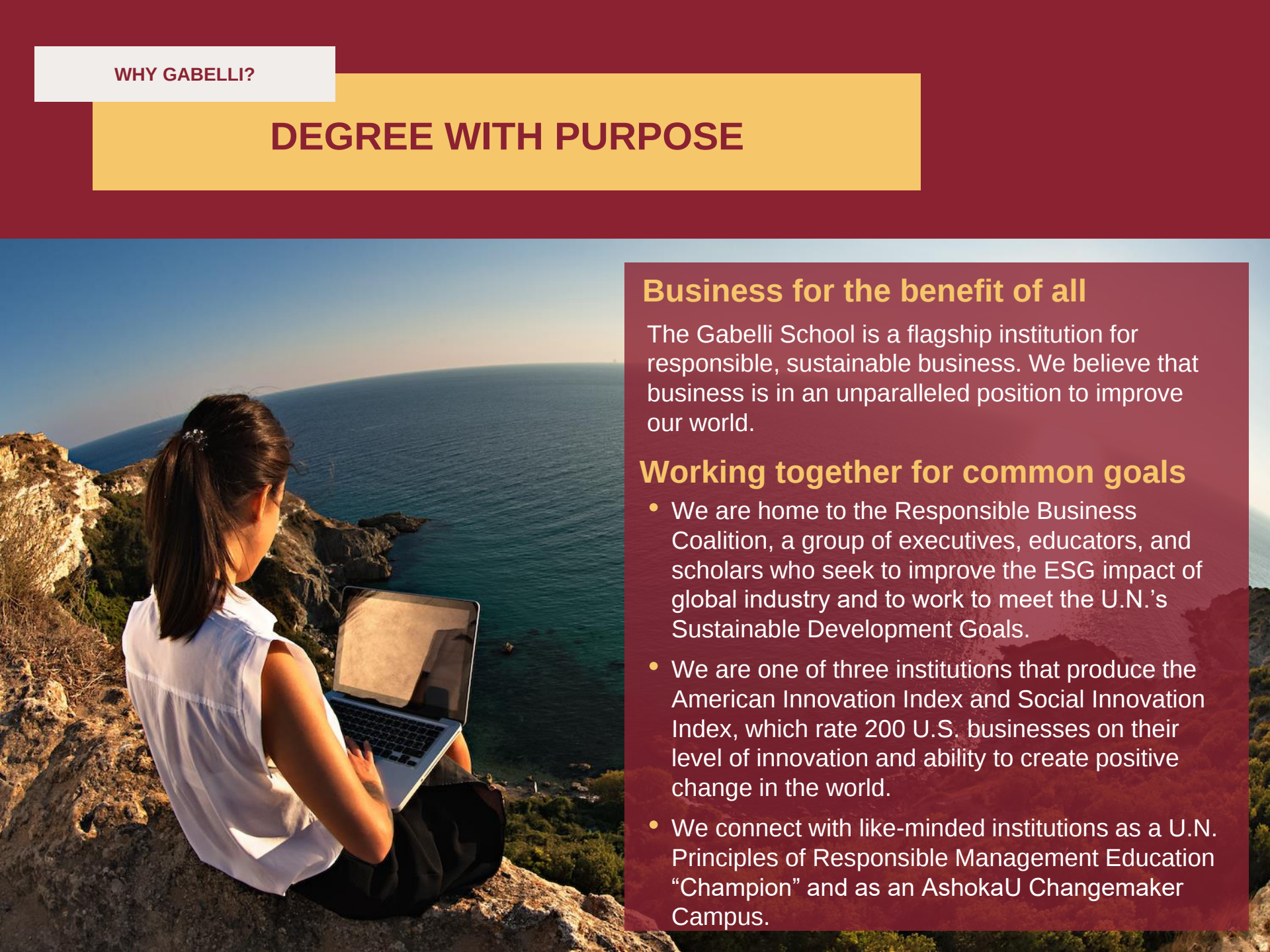

Chang Gung University students enrolled in the College of Management Bachelor's Program:

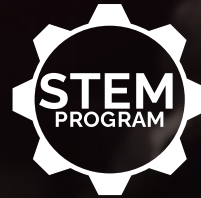
- Can complete 6-9 credits of Master's Level coursework while enrolled in the Chang Gung CoM Bachelor's Program, either:

 - At Fordham University, completing undergraduate courses abroad at the Gabelli School in NYC in final undergraduate term
- Students then enroll in the Fordham University Gabelli School of Business MS Finance Degree in NYC at conclusion of the Chang Gung Bachelor's degree, applying the 6-9 Master's credits already taken to the MSF required credits (30):

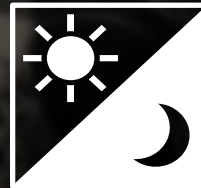

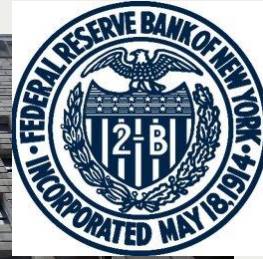

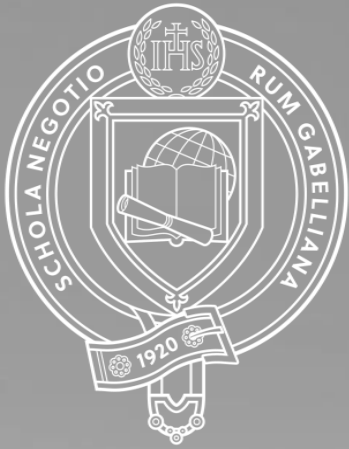
