Why study Nursing at UQ?

Entry requirements

Academic requirements

- Minimum GPA of 67% in the CGU Bachelor of Science (Nursing):
 - 3 years (or 2.5 years intensive mode) out of the 4 year degree

Application process



Submit a [UQ online application](#) no later than **30 June**.

Early applications are encouraged.

No application fee required. Contact Donna (d.guest@uq.edu.au) for a fee waiver code.



Upload your most recent CGU transcript and English test results.

We encourage students to meet the English requirements at the time of application.

English results must be provided no later than **31 July**.



UQ works with [approved agents](#) that can assist with your application.

Your agent can also assist with visa, accommodation and pre-departure enquiries.

Application process



If you receive an offer, read the offer letter carefully and provide any outstanding documents.



Accept your offer through the UQ application portal.

Once your acceptance is processed, you will be issued an invoice.



Pay your deposit to obtain your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE).



Use your CoE to apply for your student visa as soon as possible.
