

## Chang Gung University – 2026 Spring Semester (114-2)

### Health Examination Instructions for New Graduate, Undergraduate, Transfer, and International Students (Including Exchange Students)

**1. Examination Date/Time:** February 26, 2026 (Thu) 8:30–11:30 (Check-in before 11:00)

**2. Examination Location:** Linkou Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Children's Building (J Building), 2F Health Management Center.

**3. Examination Fee & Payment:** NT\$1000 (NT\$822 for exchange students). Pay at the 1F billing counter using the provided fee slip with **CASH**.

**4. Examination Items:** Please refer to the [Student Health Information Card](#). Applicable to master's and doctoral programs, undergraduate students, transfer students, and international students.

#### 5. Notes

Item	Description
1. Check-in	Go to 2J to complete check-in and receive the forms and fee slip. Verify that all personal information is correct. Complete the online basic health information and lifestyle questionnaire.
2. Height & Weight	Remove heavy clothing and take off shoes before measurement.
3. Blood Pressure	Before measuring blood pressure, rest for 5–10 minutes and relax. If blood was drawn first, rest another 5–10 minutes before taking the measurement.
4. Vision	(1) Students who normally wear glasses should keep them on during the test. Inform staff if wearing contact lenses. (2) If you have had laser eye surgery, notify the staff before the test.
5. Blood Test	(1) Fasting is not required. Continue regular medication. (2) Relax during blood draw; notify staff if unwell. After blood extraction, press firmly on the site for 5 minutes. Do not rub. (3) If you have a history of fainting, inform staff. A rest area is available.
6. Urine Test	(1) Provide mid-stream urine up to the 10 mL mark. (2) Female students who are menstruating or within one week afterward must still provide a urine sample but should notify staff.
7. Chest X-ray	(1) Wear lightweight clothing (e.g., T-shirt; seamless sports bra). Do not wear tops with underwire, zippers, buttons, sequins, or printed/raised designs. Remove necklaces, accessories, and any metal items before the exam. Do not place anything in your shirt pockets. If improper clothing affects the interpretation of the X-ray, you will need to repeat the examination at a medical facility. (2) If pregnant or possibly pregnant, notify staff and do NOT undergo X-ray.
8. Submit Forms	After completing all examination items, submit the Process Form to the collection station.
